
## Dairy fared best in the farm bill ...

# **Margin Protection Program Flawed**


#### 2014: Dairy is the problem commodity

Farmer coverage plummeted




# Margins fall ...






### ... and farms fail

Wisconsin dairy herds consolidate





# What was the policy reaction?

- Dairy baseline raised, MPP fixed in Bipartisan Budget Act (Feb. 2018)
- New Dairy Margin Coverage Plan created in 2018 farm bill (Dec. 2018)

#### **How does DMC differ?**

- More affordable, more comprehensive coverage for small producers
- More meaningful, non-distorting coverage for large producers
