

Panel a: Number, Total Area and Average Size of Farms, 1918-2003









Panel b: Gross Value of Agricultural Production by Sector, 1910-2004








## **Industry Shares of Output, 1911-2008**



## **Indices of Output Quantity, 1911-2008**




## Input Cost Shares, 1947-2008




## Public Sector Investment in/ Expenditure on Agriculture, 1911-2008


## Public Spending on RSA Agriculture, 1910 - 2007

Major revamp of R&D and extension structures Introduction of Regional Focus


#### 1971

#### 1992 to date


National Institutes taken up in National Science System Move to new political dispensation & Science Research Policy

# Institutional spread of Ag R&D Spending, 1911-2007




## South Africa vs United States vs Australia: Agriculture as a share of GDP






## South Africa vs United States vs Australia: Research Intensity




## Land-Labor Productivity, 1911-2008




## South African Agriculture, Output, Input & MFP Indexes -1947 to 2008
